Brian Todd has been coaching with the Canadian Yachting Association for 12 years and led the Canadian sailing team to gold and bronze medals at the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games. London will be his second Paralympic Games.

He also has coached windsurfing and skiing and has coached at one Olympic Games, five Canada Games and one Pan Am Games. Todd's athletes have won medals at all the sailing Games he has coached at except the 1984 Olympics.

When there is no wind for sailing, Todd loves cycling. As an athlete, Todd sailed in the Finn class and was a national team member from 1973-76.
